Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County Hosts 10th Annual Trivia Night
*Event raises funds toward continuing efforts to create quality, affordable homes
where families partner, build and buy in St. Charles County*

ST. PETERS, Mo. (March 8, 2023) – Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County is hosting its 10th Annual Trivia Night on Saturday, April 1 at 6 p.m., at the Larry Elms Training Center, 755 Parr Road in Wentzville, Missouri.

The evening offers a wide selection of raffle baskets for auction and prizes for winners. Additional fun activities include 50/50 drawings, mulligans and more. Tickets are \$25 per person, or \$200 for a table of eight players. Free bottled water, soda and beer will be available while supplies last. Attendees may bring food and beverages, but glass bottles are prohibited at the venue. Tables, tickets and sponsorships may be purchased at hfhtrivia.org

Sponsorship opportunities include:

- **The Architect.** The \$2,500 official event sponsorship includes two tables of eight players with priority seating; four courtesy bottles of wine; 20 mulligans; raffle entries; company logo on the event website and prominent signage at the event; team packets; a personal volunteer; and recognition throughout the evening by the event emcee, as well as across all Habitat's social media platforms.
- **The Project Manager.** The \$1,000 official beverage sponsorship includes one table of eight players with priority seating; two courtesy bottles of wine; 10 mulligans; company logo on the event website and prominent signage at the bar; and recognition throughout the evening across all Habitat's social media platforms.
- **The Site Supervisor.** The \$500 official auction sponsorship includes one table of eight players with priority seating; company logo on the event website; prominent signage at the event; and recognition on social media and across all Habitat outreach platforms.
- **A Round of Trivia.** Sponsoring a round of trivia is a great way to show support! The \$100 round sponsorship includes a company logo on all answer sheets, on the slideshow presentation during a sponsored round, and on the event website; as well as recognition before-and-after a round by the event emcee.

"Each year, this highly anticipated event brings together trivia enthusiasts from all over the area to enjoy an evening of fun and spirited competition," said Michelle Woods, executive director, Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County. "It's so rewarding to see individuals, teams and companies come together to participate and support our mission to enhance lives, foster relationships and build our communities one home at a time."

About Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County

Marking its 25th anniversary last year, Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County has completed the construction of 94 safe, decent and affordable homes – with additional homes underway. Each home is built by the Habitat St. Charles construction team and a selected homeowner, who join forces with more than 2,000 volunteers donating 14,000 hours each year. The nonprofit community-level affiliate acts in partnership with and on behalf of Habitat for Humanity, an international, non-governmental, nonprofit organization devoted to building strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter.

Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County offers a “hand up” opportunity that transforms lives, builds a strong foundation and forges lasting relationships with communities for a bright future. Applicants and co-applicants selected for a Habitat home agree to perform a minimum of 150 “sweat equity” hours each, for a total of at least 300-to-450 hours, in the building of their home or other Habitat projects. In collaboration with community partners, Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County offers free financial coaching and skills to potential homeowners through the Homebuyer Readiness Program, in which participants learn about credit, debt, budgeting, setting goals and saving money. In addition, the organization guides homeowners through an affordable mortgage repayment process.

To help fund and support these efforts, Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County operates the Habitat St. Charles ReStore <http://habitatstcharles.org/restore/>, a retail outlet located at 186 Mid Rivers Center in St. Peters. ReStore, which opened in 2007, has diverted over 100,000 tons of waste from local landfills by selling donated new and used building materials, appliances, furniture and select home goods items back to the general public at fair prices. Funds raised allow Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County to be self-sustaining, with nearly 100 percent of every dollar donated going directly toward building simple, decent, affordable homes for deserving families in St. Charles County. In addition, Habitat for Humanity of St. Charles County hosts an annual gala as its premier fundraiser in November, a trivia night each spring and an annual Women Build movement, an international effort to empower women to help families build strength, stability and independence through hands-on learning.
